Applicants born WITHIN the United States must bring:

- Certified copy of Birth Certificate issued by the City, County or State of birth --with seal.
- Driver's License or State I.D.
- Birth Registrations, Hospital Certificates & Baptismal Certificates are NOT acceptable.
- Note: Original documents only. Photocopies & notarized copies are NOT acceptable. Original documents will be returned when passport is issued.

Applicants born OUTSIDE the United States must bring:

- Certificate of Naturalization, Certificate of Citizenship or Consular Record of Birth
- Driver's License or State I.D.
- Note: Original documents only. Photocopies & notarized copies are NOT acceptable. Original documents will be returned when passport is issued.

Passport Costs

- Types of payment accepted: CASH or CHECK ONLY. Passport and processing fees must be collected at the time the application is submitted.
- Fees must be paid SEPARATELY. If paying by check, please write ONE check for the Passport Fee to the Department of State and ONE check for Processing & Picture Fee to Postmaster USPS.
