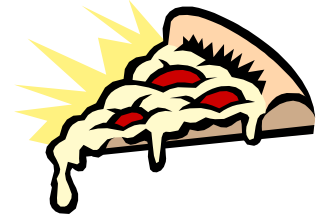

Faculty, staff and students get together to enjoy pizza and mingle.

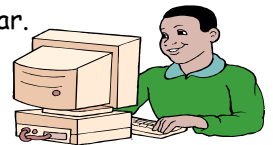


1:00 - 1:50 PM **Scavenger Hunt** (*North Campus*)

Prizes will be awarded for the scavenger hunt at this time.





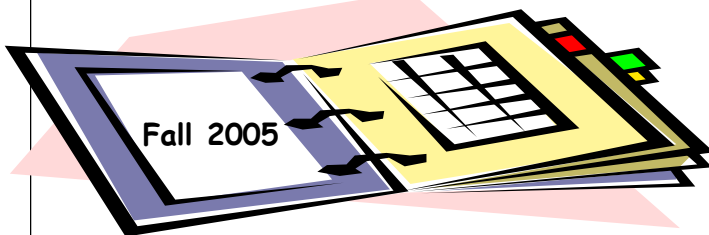

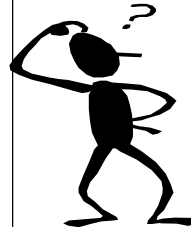
